

I am writing to inform you that **Dr. Omar Abdullah Hazzazi** will have completed his postdoctoral training programme in electrochemistry on 28th August 2003. In the training period he has utilised a variety of modern surface sensitive analytical techniques including scanning tunnelling microscopy and electrochemical wall-jet to investigate and characterise several electrocatalytic reactions on well-defined chiral single crystal electrodes. We are presently writing several papers on this work for publication in high quality journals including *J. Phys. Chem.*, *J. Am. Chem. Soc.* and *J. Electroanal. Chem.*. **Dr. Hazzazi** has continued to demonstrate his unique abilities in expediting a complex and arduous programme of research. I consider him to be one of the best students that I have ever had in my laboratory and am in no doubt that when he returns to Saudi Arabia he will be of great assistance and benefit to the Saudi educational system, both as a teacher and as a research worker. Therefore it only remains to thank Umm Al-Qura university for granting permission for **Dr. Hazzazi** to prolong his stay in the UK and to increase his knowledge of electrochemistry. I would be very pleased to welcome **Dr. Hazzazi** back to work in my laboratory at any future date since he has proved to be an excellent scientist and colleague.
